Audition Process

Candidates perform **from memory** one movement of any concerto of their choice. Candidates must provide their own accompanist; include the accompanist's name on the application to avoid scheduling errors. Preliminary auditions will last no more than ten minutes. Candidates should be prepared to play the entirety of the same movement, including cadenzas, for the final audition. A legible copy of the solo part must be provided for the judges.

Eligibility

Candidates must be:

- ages 10 to 21
- a North Carolina resident or enrolled full-time in a North Carolina school (proof of residency may be required at the audition)
- available for both audition dates
